Director Herringa received a \$1000 grant for summer reading from the Mid Michigan Library League and assisted with the Friends of the Library at their garden program. She met briefly with John Riley, who will be facilitating the de-escalation training for the staff on May 1st. The

admin team met with Libraria to potentially replace Baker & Taylor as a full-processing book vendor. Pat O'Herron will be out for an extended period, so Director Herringa has hired a temporary cleaner. Director Herringa plans to send Kim Jankowiak to the upcoming American Library Association conference in Chicago. She and Business Manager Barker applied for a \$25,000 grant from the Carnegie Corporation for digital literacy.
